To enter into force, the agreement reached in Paris in December 2015 must be ratified by at least 55 countries accounting for 55% of greenhouse gas emissions. A threshold is now at hand. With India and its approximately 4% of global emissions, a total of 62 countries representing nearly 52% of global emissions have ratified the agreement. China and the United States, the two most polluting countries, helped to speed up the process by ratifying the text early September." French President Hollande stated. Source Elysee
